

Instructions for including your Stand Up and Speak Out event in the global count

Stand Up and Speak Out is the growing movement of people no longer prepared to stay seated or silent in the face of poverty and inequality. People around the world have 24 hours in which to break the Guinness World Record for the largest number of people to Stand Up and Speak Out to Make Poverty History.

On October 16 and 17, PSAC members will be joining people around the world by standing up and speaking out at their own events.

When must your event take place:

To be counted, events in Canada must take place between the following times:

British Columbia and Yukon: October 16 at 2:00 p.m. and October 17 at 2:00 p.m.

Northwest Territories, Nunavut (mountain), Alberta, Saskatchewan: October 16 at 3:00 p.m. and October 17 at 3:00 p.m.

Nunavut (central), Manitoba and western Ontario: October 16 at 4:00 p.m. and October 17 at 4:00 p.m.

Nunavut (eastern), Ontario (eastern) and Quebec: October 16 at 5:00 p.m. and October 17 at 5:00 p.m.

New Brunswick, Prince Edward Island and Nova Scotia: October 16 at 6:00 p.m. and October 17 at 6:00 p.m.

Newfoundland and Labrador: October 16 at 6:30 p.m. and October 17 at 6:30 p.m.

Note: members are encouraged to participate in the count by raising their hand if standing up is not possible.
